## **Exploring Enterprise Programme (EEP)**

Exploring Enterprise Programme (EEP) is a free programme which provides an insight into starting a business or allows you to take the first steps to gaining employment. You do not need to have a business idea to join.

The programme offers mentoring and training tailored to your needs and the opportunity to work towards achieving a CCEA Level 1 Qualification in Understanding Business Enterprise.

You will be provided with one to one mentoring with an experienced business advisor in areas such as:

- Marketing
- Financial Planning
- Introduction to HMRC
- Job searching/assisting in writing of job applications
- CV design / development
- Searching for further education courses or other relevant training

To be eligible for this programme you must be:

- Aged 16 or over
- Legally able to reside and work in the UK
- Unemployed/inactive or working/studying less than 16 hours per week;
- Not participating in any other government funded programme


